Features include:

- RAID configured high speed hard drives are used for the archive.
- Backup from hard drives to LTO2 Ultrium tape.
- Regular refresh of tape backups.

- Backup tapes stored off site.
- No upper limit of file size or storage space.
- The RAID storage and tape library systems are housed in an environmentally controlled server room with intruder alarm and access control allowing entry to only authorised personnel.
- Uninterruptible power supply to servers, ensuring a tidy shut-down in the event of a mains power failure.
