Since 1993, iBase digital asset management and online library systems have been under continuous development and contributing to technological advances world-wide, for both internal and web based digital asset management requirements.

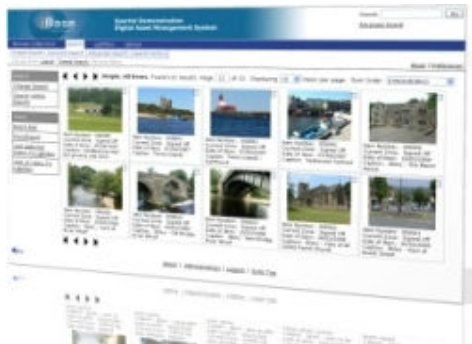

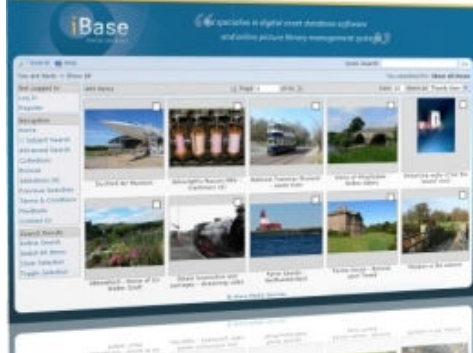
