1. Acceptance of these terms and conditions

2. iBase licence and data ownership

The software licence is owned by and remains the property of iBase Media Services Ltd. The data uploaded by the user is owned by and remains the property of the user.

3. Definition of Software as a Service (SaaS)

For the purposes of these terms and conditions, SaaS means that it is only available when hosted by iBase Media Services. If a locally hosted iBase system is required, please contact iBase Media Services through our website or by sending an email to sales@ibase.com.

4. Prices

5. Additional storage space

Additional storage space can be bought at the prices displayed at https://www.ibase.com/Pricing.

6. Data transfer allowance

Up to 100GB of data transfer out per month is included in the prices shown at https://www.ibase.com/Pricing. Additional data transfer can be provided, please contact support@ibase.com with your requirements.

7. Cessation of free service

For the free option only as shown at https://www.ibase.com/Pricing, if the system is not accessed during any six-month period, or in any other circumstances at the discretion of iBase Media Services, the service will be ceased. Two weeks' notice will be given during which the client may retrieve their assets if they wish. When iBase Media Services cease a service, all assets and associated metadata will be irretrievably deleted.

8. Languages

iBase is provided with UK English language menus, navigations bars, messages etc... Data can be entered in any Unicode-supported language.

9. Customisation and other ad-hoc work
